Encapsulation Mechanics & Preventative Maintenance

TRAINING SUMMARY:

This **24-hour** training focuses on advanced aspects of capsules and filling, and an in-depth look at the preventative maintenance required in the lower portion of the encapsulation machine. SOPs and SPCs will be emphasized, as well as operation of the indexing/sorting station, disassembly/reassembly, tooling evaluation, alignments, tamper/dosing and powder characteristics. Students will experience demonstration techniques, student-teacher interaction and hands-on experience. Seasoned technical services professionals will facilitate individual use of a state-of-the-art high-speed filling machine.
