Overview of Capsule Filling Technology

TRAINING SUMMARY:

This 8-hour training focuses on the evolution of capsules and filling in the dietary supplement and pharmaceutical industries, basic identification of universal filling machine parts and stations, basic GMP's, SPC's, and safety on a high speed filling machine, powder characteristics, and the dial in process, yields, cleaning and recordkeeping on the machine. Students will experience demonstration techniques, and student-teacher interaction. Seasoned technical services professionals will facilitate individual use of a state-of-the-art high speed-filling machine. **Those not already working in the nutraceutical field will be guaranteed an interview with a local dietary supplement manufacturer upon successful completion of this class.**
